

1A Auto, Inc. leases 17,000 s/f at Pepperell Place Business Center

Pepperell, MA Massachusetts-based online auto parts retailer 1A Auto, Inc. has signed a lease for 17,000 s/f at Pepperell Place Business Center, and will bring 20 jobs to town. 1A is one of the country's largest online sellers of auto parts, employing over 450 around the country, including in Pepperell, Littleton and Westford.
