In fact, it was and still is the tallest building in Brighton and the former home of Charlie Baker's gubernatorial campaign headquarters. We turned it into Nova Residences, a six-story, 68,000 s/f building with 80 residential units – including studios, lofts and a mix of one- and two-bedroom apartments that represent the highest standard of living and conveniences that modern lifestyles demand.
