Based in Patchogue N.Y., this will be the company's 30th store and the first in Mass. by franchisees Natalie and Sylvia Rocha.

Expedia CruiseShip Centers will occupy another 1,540 s/f inline retail suite in the same shopping center and will open its doors in February 2019. Expedia CruiseShipCenters, based in Vancouver B.C. Canada, is a travel agency franchise company, specializing in marketing and sales of cruise vacations worldwide. Franchisee Mark Dawson's Beverly location will be the company's 236th location.
