monthly programs. However, the events have been so much more popular they have garnered 20-40 attendees at each pop up.

The inaugural pop up was at Red Lantern in the Back Bay in March just prior to the FMForward conference. The next one in April was held in Downtown Crossing at Yvonne's and last week, to celebrate summer, the group popped up at the Hotel Envoy's rooftop.

The Engagement Committee chaired by Sandra Gucciardi of STV|DPM and Colby Fillippelli of JLL@Dunkin' Brands has received so much positive feedback from the attendees. It's been an amazing way for our new members to test the waters with a smaller crowd and a shorter commitment window. We've also seen a lot of repeat attendees proving a successful concept.
