

## J. M. Coull presents first annual Daniel A. Mahoney Scholarship

J.M. Coull has presented Fitchburg State College junior, Sean Cruise of Lakeville, Mass. with the inaugural Daniel A. Mahoney Scholarship. The award was presented to Cruise by J.M. Coull president Andrew Coull, and project manager Marc Moschella, an alumnus himself of Fitchburg State.

Named for a long-time employee of J.M. Coull who exemplified professionalism in construction management, the Daniel Mahoney Scholarship will be given each year for five years to a qualified industrial technology/construction technology junior-year student.

The final selection was made by J. M. Coull's management team.

Cruise rose to the top of the nominations for his essay in which he expressed a longstanding passion for construction.

"Sean's outstanding academics and professional skills exemplify the caliber of students in our program," said James Andrews, associate professor of industrial technology. "This scholarship further solidifies our relationship with J.M. Coull and helps us in our mission of supporting construction technology professionals at Fitchburg State.
