

## IFMA Boston holds successful virtual conference

Boston, MA Due to the COVID-19 situation, IFMA Boston's annual one day conference—FMForward was held as a four day summit from June 8-11 from noon to 1:30 p.m. each day and was underwritten by VVA LLC. The conference kicked off with a keynote address entitled "Managing with a Coach Approach" with Joe Hirsch, managing director of Semaca Partners LLC. Hirsch is an entrepreneur, educator and TedTalk speaker. His address was engaging and interactive and was a great way to kick off the event.

During the keynote address, Hirsch recognized the project Awards of Excellence recipients for this year. Two FMs received the Excellence in Facility Management awards for their projects—Tom Weber of UMASS Lowell and Brian Murray of Akamai Technologies.
