In addition to serving on the board and its executive committee, Shanahan served as treasurer for 15 years, and assistant treasurer for one year. He was awarded the Volunteer of the Year award in 2009, was one of two recipients of the President's Award presented in 2010, and received the Founder's Award in 2016 for his instrumental role in the organization.
