"The new space enables us to continue to leverage Woburn's diverse high-technology talent pool and procure more equipment that will expand our capacity to provide the most innovative, industry-leading products to our global clients."

Innovations in Optics was also attracted to the existing infrastructure at 10 Gill St., according to Cummings Properties account manager Kara Murphy, who worked with the firm on the expansion. Features of the space include a private loading dock, 17-foot clear warehouse, private windowed offices, and a boardroom.

The new facility will support Innovations in Optics' continued growth by allowing it to move its manufacturing operations in house. It will also be home to the firm's administrative office and product design functions.
