Viking Construction named Top 2020 Family-Owned Business

Bridgeport, CT Viking Construction was named as one of the top family-owned businesses in Connecticut by The Hartford Business Journal. Anthony Gaglio, Jr., serves on the board of directors for Inspirica, Inc., a non-profit that works to solve homelessness, and on the board of incorporators for the Fairfield County Bank. The company and its employees support countless local nonprofits including sports teams and food banks. The company also created the annual Viking Construction Education Scholarship program in 2012 to encourage high school seniors or college students who have declared a construction-related major.
