Quonset also affords access to the Northeast rail corridor and 14 miles of freight rail lines in the Park as well as both RI Rte. 4 and I-95 highways. With additional proximity to three airports – T.F. Green (RI), Logan International (MA), and Bradley International (CT) and nearby train routes like the MBTA and Amtrak, businesses and employees alike have the options they need to access new markets.
