MDI manufactures a complete range of PRO-SERIES nonwoven wiping products that are designed for use in critical cleaning applications in workplaces worldwide. Family owned and operated for three generations, the company is a WBENC-Certified Women's Business Enterprise and has an ISO 9001:2015 certified Quality Management System. After moving their corporate headquarters and manufacturing operations to Shelton 25 years ago with new construction at 10 Waterview Dr., MDI now has plans for a second custom facility to accommodate ongoing growth and diversification.
