He oversaw Tishman Speyer's global portfolio, which consisted of 100 million s/f comprising more than 112 assets in 29 markets and eight countries, with an emphasis on business development, managing key corporate client relationships, and multi-market leasing, development and acquisition activity as well as property management, client services and operations.
