On May 26th, BOMA Boston is hosting a Tech Tour: Cannistraro Fabrication Facility at Black Falcon Pier. "The Fid" as it's called which stands for (F)abrication, (I)ndustry, (D)esign is a 160,000 s/f manufacturing facility, which is equivalent to four acres. The building was originally built for the U.S. Navy as a metal fabrication shop and ship repair facility in 1941 to support the efforts of WWII.
