On Thursday, May 26th, BOMA Boston hosted a Tech Tour: Cannistraro Fabrication Facility at Black Falcon Pier. "The Fid" as it's called which stands for (F)abrication, (I)ndustry, (D)esign is a 160,000 s/f manufacturing facility, which is equivalent to four acres. The building was originally built for the U.S. Navy as a metal fabrication shop and ship repair facility in 1941 to support the efforts of WWII. A complete renovation of the facility was finished in June of 2018. Close to 30 engineers and facility managers enjoyed the tour and learned about the state-of-the-art facility.

On Thursday, July 14th, BOMA will be hosting a Roundtable on Insights from the Pros. The roundtable will be led by Phil Boccalatte, vice president, Rockhill Management; Chuck Hurchalla, president, Evolution Energy Partners; Gregg Laufersweiler, vice president, sales and marketing, Stanley Elevator; and Clayton Wentworth, RPA, vice president-portfolio manager, Alexandria Real Estate Equities, Inc., BOMA 2022 treasurer.
