nine-story, 289,000 s/f facility marks the first purpose-built class A lab building in the city of Somerville as part of the Boynton Yards mixed-use life sciences and cultural community. Together with DLJ Real Estate Capital Partners and Leggat McCall Properties, we recently cut the opening ribbon and welcomed four newly founded flagship pioneering companies to the building—which features state-of-the-art R&D lab space, fitness center, bike amenities, four levels of below-grade parking, and ground floor community space. Having witnessed how proud the stakeholders are of the project and knowing that our team created their vision flawlessly is what makes me proud. Additionally, our project team executed the plan and delivered the project on time and on budget despite pandemic-related challenges and lockdowns.
