Public officials and retail real estate professionals will hold panel discussions on how to overcome the current obstacles in a weakened economy. This and more will be discussed at the International Council of Shopping Centers, Inc. 2008 Connecticut Alliance Program, taking place on Thursday, November 6th at 11 a.m. at the Hartford Marriot Downtown.

The luncheon keynote presentation will be given by David Wood, director of The Institute for Responsible Investment. This presentation will look at how to reduce the negative environmental impacts of real estate development while maintaining economic growth.
