CoreNet Global New England continues CREST intern program

Boston, MA This year marks the 5th consecutive year that CoreNet Global New England and the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee (DEI) have partnered with The Commercial Real Estate Success Training (CREST). CREST is a paid internship program designed to introduce those historically underrepresented in corporate and commercial real estate to these industries in the New England region.

This year, CoreNet Global New England created ten mentor/mentee relationships with leaders in the local corporate real estate industry and CREST interns. Seven of the 26 students who interned this summer with the CREST Program from June 13 to August 12, interned with CoreNet Global New England corporate partners or founders circle sponsor organizations, including J.
