Portland, ME E4H Environments for Health Architecture received IIDA New England's award for Best Project in Health/Wellness for the design of the Glickman Lauder Center of Excellence in Autism and Developmental Disorders (CADD).

The new 28,000 s/f facility at 37 Andover Rd. consolidates services under one roof: adult and children's treatment programs, outpatient care, and clinical research. Designers collaborated with

staff to create a calming, supportive environment for ASD through sensory zoning, acoustics, and biophilic design. The IIDA New England awards honor the work and celebrates the teams behind each year's most show-stopping spaces throughout New England. The health and wellness award honors the project that best promotes health & well-being and considers the physical, mental, and emotional effects of design on building occupants.
