After canceling the event for two years due to COVID-19, the CAC and its donors achieved a record-breaking \$593,925 of funds raised.

Contributing to this total, the benefit featured various raffles with opportunities for guests to bid on unique experiences and gifts. Attendees also enjoyed a cocktail hour with hors d'oeuvres, a buffet-style dinner, and a live auction led by Journalist Janet Wu and Mike Fish.
