Nantucket restaurant, Stubbys, opens first off-island location at the Seaport

Boston, MA Stubbys, the Nantucket eatery known for its classic menu and friendly service, is opening its first mainland location in the Seaport. The restaurant is set to open this month and will offer customers an expansive menu covering breakfast, lunch, dinner, and late-night.

Founded in 2000 out of a fish market on Nantucket's historic Broad St. with the intent of serving french fries to visitors coming on and off the ferries, Stubbys quickly became a staple of the island's dining scene. They earned a die-hard following of locals and tourists of all ages, serving up their take on classic American and Jamaican food. Decades later, Stubbys is ready to expand, bringing its menu to the Seaport.

The new Stubbys will span 1,805 s/f, far surpassing the size of its Nantucket location, while still maintaining the charm of the original. Upon entering, guests will be greeted by a welcoming ambiance accentuated by wooden furnishings and brick walls. Stubbys will be adorned with

photographs depicting its Nantucket history, evoking the island's heritage and community. Lively music will fill the space with a variety of classic rock to tropical house beats in the evening. While exploring the new location, guests can anticipate branded Stubbys giveaways, samples, and more.

Stubbys is located at 43 Northern Ave. and will be open seven days a week from 6:30 am to 11:00 pm.

The menu will cover classic breakfast, lunch, dinner, and late-night bites, with a range of dishes that showcase the flavors of Nantucket and beyond. Breakfast will feature a variety of breakfast sandwiches such as the Hungry Man and breakfast burritos. For lunch and dinner, customers can indulge in Stubbys specialties like the jerk chicken sandwich, fish and chips, a classic cheeseburger and more. Stubbys will also offer to-go and online orders through various food delivery providers.

"We're so proud of what we've created over the years with our Stubbys family on Nantucket and feel honored to bring it off island in this next chapter that still feels really connected to the history. We have been so intentional in selecting materials, vendors, staff for this new restaurant and can't wait to meet our new customers in person," said Stubbys managing partner, Saugat Mali. "For us, it's so much more than serving great, classic food. It's creating a community of people who greet each other by name, stay to enjoy good company, and come back for the way it made them feel."

Stubbys partner Scott Kopp says Stubbys finds success by focusing on the people, "We have employees who become family and customers who become friends. What makes Stubbys different is the warm, fun environment that customers love and come for year after year on Nantucket. It's our hope that Stubbys Boston will become that same familiar neighborhood establishment where customers always feel welcome."
