

DApice of The Mega Group sells 50-unit The Princeton for \$11m to ViceRoy Capital Management

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Somerville, MA The Mega Group brokered the \$11 million sale of 333 Broadway at a 4.29% capitalization rate. The subject property known as The Princeton is a 50-unit multi-family brick apartment building built in 1914 and situated on Winter Hill. Featuring six two-bedroom, 27 one-bedroom and 17 studio apartments with heat included in the rents and separate electric throughout. At the time of the sale, gross income was \$786,708 with a net income of \$471,476.

ViceRoy Capital Management and its managers Sandra Capo and Carl Valeri were the buyers.

Brian DApice of The Mega Group represented the buyers.

DApice said, "It was an off-market deal and a difficult transaction to work on, I had very little time to act in selecting an investor that possessed the ability to navigate through the sales process of a high-vacancy quintessential value-add opportunity, while at the same time had the ability to execute a purchase contract with no contingencies."
