

Lila Delman Compass and Vanderbilt International sell 'The Orchard' for \$10.8 million

'The Orchard' is a historic home along the Cliff Walk, offering 14 bedrooms, 13 full and 4 half baths and over 20,000 s/f of living space. Built in 1873, the mansion, carriage house and gardens were thoughtfully restored in 2019. The property includes the finest craftsmanship throughout including dentil molding, paneling, marble floors, handcrafted mahogany doors, Baccarat crystal chandeliers, and marble fireplaces, and most are original to the mansion. Built of yellow Milwaukee brick and Ohio limestone, this home is on 4.75 acres of gardens.
