BOMI: Environmental Health & Safety Issues – accelerated – will start on Tuesday April 15th and conclude on Thursday April 17th virtual via Zoom from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Led by instructor Brendan Reilly, national business development director, ATI Restoration, students will learn best practices for developing and managing an effective environmental health and safety program. You will learn about the regulatory process and how it affects facilities. Compliance with laws and regulations is a key focus. The course will prepare you to conduct site assessments, analyze risk, and cooperate with compliance audits. The course also guides learners through the planning process to mitigate the risk from any workplace emergency, specifically addressing hazardous materials, air quality, water pollution, asbestos, and lead hazards, and tank management. The management of and response to specific indoor environmental quality complaints is also addressed.
