Key features of the new center include:

- Gross Motor Skill Space: A large, open area for free play, featuring a ninja gym and a sectioned-off space with climbing equipment for infants and younger children.
- STEAM Lab: A classroom-style space designed for schoolwork, projects and experiments, encouraging creativity and hands-on learning.
- Teen Center: A dedicated space for teens with a tech bar, social zones and gaming area.

The hub's design reflects a vibrant, outdoor-inspired aesthetic with bright colors, painted mountain murals and custom tree details that encourage creativity. These thoughtful elements align with the program's mission to nurture growth, confidence and innovation in local youth.

A ribbon-cutting ceremony held on January 14 celebrated the opening of the hub with a state dedication, bringing together donors, community members and excited young attendees. The event featured speeches from YMCA leadership and allowed individuals of all ages to explore the new spaces.
