The center is also improved by a freestanding AutoZone, Wendy's and Mattress Firm that were not part of the sale. The Aldi-anchored center is located at the intersection of Tobey Rd. and Cranberry Hwy., and benefits from planning during development with four points of access, and visibility and frontage that have been maximized by each building's positioning on the site. The properties are situated off the I-195 exit 21-on/off ramp, and 1,000 ft. from the junction of I-495 and 195.
