The event, "AI and Its Impact on Commercial Real Estate Analytics" brings together industry experts to share valuable perspectives on how AI is reshaping decision-making, workflows, and risk management in the CRE space.

The featured speaker is Craig Scott, partner with Hinckley Allen, based in Boston and Providence. Scott leads Hinckley Allen's intellectual property and artificial intelligence practice groups and is a trusted advisor on AI's impact on licensing, patents, trademarks, copyright, and trade secrets in business.
