It's easy to nod and agree even if in the back of your head you have no idea what they're talking about. I encourage you to ask for clarification if something confuses you. Eventually all the dots will connect together! Knowledge is power.

Who has played a pivotal role in your development, and how have they influenced you? Elizabeth Von Goeler, currently a principal at Sasaki - I worked with her during a turning point in my initial career. I was 3- 5 years out of school, beginning to take on more responsibilities, and trying to find my voice as a young designer, figuring out how I should present myself at work. I was quieter and more timid in those first few years. Working with her, I was able to observe how intelligent and captivating she was in meetings with clients, cracking jokes and having fun while also effortlessly getting every point across for our designs.
