Recent LEED projects include the \$7.8 million Silver Level LEED Certified Portsmouth Public Library in Portsmouth, NH; the \$18.9 million Gold Level LEED Certified Fahey and McLane Residence Halls at Dartmouth College in Hanover, NH; and North Branch Construction's own new Corporate Headquarters in Concord, NH, currently awaiting Silver Level LEED certification.
