


The Heyman Enterprise celebrates ribbon cutting and official opening of 18 DOCK

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Stamford, CT The highly anticipated 18 DOCK luxury apartment high-rise apartment building celebrated their official opening with a ribbon-cutting ceremony with mayor Caroline Simmons and representatives from The Heyman Enterprise, marking a significant milestone in the city's South End transformation.

Additional tours showcased the thoughtfully designed model units across all residence types, including studios, one-, two- and three-bedroom apartments, and two-bedroom duplex apartments, each featuring generous ceiling heights, custom millwork, state-of-the-art technology, and finishes from wood plank floors to premium appliances.

From the finishes to the resort like amenities and welcoming arrival experience, not a detail has been left behind. The amenities include the elevated outdoor green space and landscaped sky deck, on the seventh floor, a pool, hot tub, barbeques, firepits, sun loungers and cabanas for privacy to

the fitness center, game room/ golf simulator, chef's kitchen, entertainment pavilion, screening room and fully wired co-working lounge - all featuring 16 ft., floor-to-ceiling windows with downtown city views.

Conveniences found on the main floor include a 24-hour doorman and concierge, automated mail room, storage spaces, bike storage, a dog salon and enclosed parking garage. Other notable community details include walkability to the train, the waterfront and downtown shopping, direct water views and resident perks at local eateries, retail boutiques, cultural arts and "sportstainment" centers.
