

Tenant Appreciation Day held at Fairfield Executive Center

The new Metro North station scheduled to open in July 2010 prompted a well-attended Tenant Appreciation Day recently at the Fairfield Executive Center, 1375 Kings Hwy. East.

As part of Tenant Appreciation Day, Abbey Road Advisors, the owner of 1375 Kings Hwy.
