

CB Richard Ellis arranges 17,350 s/f sublease for Related Properties

Spencer Trask & Co., a leading private equity firm focused on co-developing paradigm-shifting businesses, which traces its roots back to Thomas Edison and Edison Electric (now known as the General Electric Company), has signed a 17,350 s/f long term sublease at 1700 East Putnam Ave. The deal is one of the largest transactions in Greenwich this year to date. In addition, Cuddy and Wiesenberg serve as the leasing agent for Related Properties Corporation at 1700 East Putnam Ave. located just minutes from Exits 5 and 6 off I-95 and the Stamford and Old Greenwich Metro-North train stations. The property provides easy access to New York City and points beyond as well as the opportunity for companies to draw from the Tri-State Region's deepest and most diverse labor pools.
