The LEED professional accreditation program is rigorous, requiring participants to satisfy a number of criteria covering a wide range of sustainable construction and development issues. The certification process for buildings uses the LEED Green Building Rating System, a consensus-based national green building standard for the construction industry.

Petrillo's accreditation is part of a company-wide program whereby all key EMCOR personnel coast-to-coast will become accredited under the guidelines of USGBC's LEED program.
