

## Cost Effective Marketing seminar to be Jan. 28; Solutions for the Top Ten Mistakes Remodelers Make on Feb. 25

It was brainstorming time for the Rhode Island Builders Association's remodelers as they gathered for a round-table discussion at their regular monthly meeting.

A suggestion also arose that RIBA remodelers find ways to promote themselves at future Home Shows. There was even time for some contractor-to-contractor advice on dealing with problems working with slate during a current high-end remodel.
