NAIOP's 21st Annual Golf Tournament to tee off on June 3rd

Held June 3rd on four courses in Stow, the tournament is expected to draw 500+ commercial real estate professionals for a fun day of golf, networking, and doing good!

Registration is \$400 per person, or \$1,500 per foursome, and include green fees, golf cart, special gifts, lunch, and the popular networking reception.
