

Regency Centers' Boston office moves to Twin City Plaza in Somerville

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According to Regency Centers, the development, leasing and property management offices in Boston will move to one of the company's shopping centers in Somerville. According to Andy Couch, Regency Centers vice president of investments, the new office will be located at Twin City Plaza, I-4 and 22 McGrath Hwy.
