

## MassDevelopment seeks green housing RFQ for two sites in Devens

MassDevelopment announced a first-in-state request for qualifications (RFQ) seeking development teams to design, construct and sell moderately-priced green homes on two sites in Devens. The project is intended to provide a replicable example of current and innovative sustainable building practices that are both practical for Massachusetts and affordable to moderate-income homebuyers.

MassDevelopment will review the RFQ submissions and select up to five qualified respondents in August. The chosen teams will receive a \$5,000 stipend and an invitation to respond to a request for proposals (RFP) to develop green housing on two lots at Devens totaling 4.6-acres on Bates St. and Adams Circle. The agency will choose a developer in spring 2010 with an anticipated groundbreaking in May 2010, and project completion in early 2011.
