Suffolk Healthcare fits out new Fenway Health at 1340 Boylston St.

The 100,000 s/f facility includes examination rooms, treatment facilities, therapy rooms, a street-level retail pharmacy, state-of-the-art auditorium and conference center, and office space.

Suffolk Healthcare closely coordinated efforts with the Suffolk-led project team that was managing construction of the 1330 Boylston St. base building. In addition, Fenway's Women's Health program has its own dedicated space on the building's third floor.
