Bufftree completes new 4,700 s/f St. George Greek Orthodox Church

Parishioners of St. George Greek Orthodox Church celebrated the fruition of their dream of a new place to worship with the Thyanoixia, or Opening of the Doors, of the congregation's new St. George Greek Orthodox Church and Hellenic Cultural Center built by south coast-based Bufftree Building Company.

Phase 2 of the project would convert this building into a function hall only and construct a more grand church to the south with a connecting link between the two.
