

Bufftree completes Phase I of Greek Orthodox Church project

Bufftree Building Company completed Phase I relocation of St. George Greek Orthodox Church and Hellenic Cultural Center from Ashley Blvd. to a 6-acre site on Cross Rd. across from the George H. Potter School.

This official opening of the 4,700 s/f, handicapped-accessible building contains a church with a seating capacity of 160, an attached function room for 60 persons and administrative offices.

Rescom Architectural, Inc. was the architect for the project.

Phase 2 of the project would convert this building into a function hall only and construct a more grand church to the south with a connecting link between the two.
